

Levi Freeski Area



Note that off-piste skiing requires sufficient technique. Off-piste skiing is on your own responsibility.

Do not go skiing alone. Take a friend with you and get to know the area in advance from www.levi.ski/en/northeast slopes.

Gear up right - always wear a helmet. Back protector and other protective gear are recommended.

Keep the changing conditions in mind. There might be trees, rocks and stumps that can't be seen. Be aware of lift towers, buildings and changing terrain.

Don't go skiing to the freeski area when it's getting dark as there are no lights.

Check the Finnish Meteorological Institute's website en.ilmatieteenlaitos.fi/avalanche-forecast for current avalanche warnings.

Don't be afraid to back up if you are unsure of the conditions. If you have any hesitations ask the Ski Patrol or resort staff for more information.

Before heading to the freeski area tell someone where you're going and when you are planning to come back. Let them know when you have returned.
